- Submit abstract using the online submission form by **November 12, 2017** at **11:59pm**.
- Online submissions only.
- You <u>may</u> submit more than one abstract per person presenter/senior author, but only one will be accepted for an oral and/or poster presentation.
- Upload graph or charts in .jpg format only (not counted in the 3,000 characters)
- The abstract body (not counting abstract title or author string) must not exceed 3,000 characters.
- The entry should represent original work done by the authors.
- Submitted work **must be unpublished**, accepted for publication, or won previous awards.
- Submission of an abstract constitutes a *commitment* by the submitting author to be present on **February 22-24, 2018** if his/her abstract is accepted.
- Please structure your abstract using the following headings: **Background**, **Objective**, **Methods**, **Results**, **Conclusion**.

SELF ASSESSMENT QUESTIONS

To help our members comply with the new requirements for Maintenance of Certification by the American Board of Surgery, we will offer **CME credits with self-assessment**. All authors will be required to submit two multiple-choice questions. Your questions will be reviewed by members of the program committee prior to inclusion in the CME program.

The questions are intended to demonstrate the attendee's understanding of the material presented. Therefore, the **questions should be readily answered from the presentation**. Please avoid questions that are overly complex or tricky.

- You must submit at least 4 multiple choice answers per question.
- Each multiple choice answer cannot contain the following verbiage "all the above, none of the above, both a and b", etc.
- The correct answer should be in Answer #1.
- Please include CASE-BASED questions.
